332 Regulation of Dangerous Weapons on ESD Premises

Definitions: For purposes of this policy dangerous weapons are defined as any firearm, dagger, sword, knife, or other cutting or stabbing instrument, club, or any other weapon apparently capable of producing bodily harm (RCW 9.41.270).

It is a violation of district policy for any person to carry a firearm or dangerous weapon on ESD premises or other facilities used exclusively by the ESD.

This policy does not apply to persons engaged in law enforcement or security activities.

Persons conducting legitimate business at the ESD may have firearms in their possession on ESD property outside of the building if they are in lawful possession of the firearm and the firearm is secured in a locked vehicle.

Persons over eighteen years may possess personal protection spray devices on ESD property. Spray devices may not be used other than in self-defense as defined by state law.

The ESD shall notify the appropriate law enforcement agency of known or suspected violations of the state law regulating dangerous weapons.
