CALL TO ORDER

The ESD 112 Board of Directors' Business meeting was called to order by Darlene Stickel, *President*, at 3:00 pm on August 23, 2022. A quorum of five members were present.

INTRODUCTIONS AND WELCOME OF GUESTS

REPORTS AND DISCUSSION

- <u>ESD Campus Facilities Tour</u>: All present were taken on a tour of the ESD main campus highlighting the new construction of additional meeting rooms and the new mental health center in the 2400 building.
- Early Head Start and ECEAP Program Monthly Report: Jodi Wall, Executive Director of Early Care and Education, shared highlights of the monthly report including additional funding from state and federal COVID relief funds to assist families in need of groceries and supplies, as well as purchasing equipment and supplies for programs. Heidi Rosenberg shared that ideas are being considered to encourage parent participation in Policy Council Meetings.
- <u>Cabinet Retreat Update</u>: Tim Merlino, *Superintendent*, and cabinet members shared an update work done at the recent cabinet retreat. Mike Nerland, *Assistant Superintendent of Teaching & Learning*, reviewed current behavioral and mental health tiered supports for students that are currently in place for districts as well as existing barriers to additional needed services.
- <u>First Reading New Board Policy 3411</u>: Mike Nerland, Assistant Superintendent of Teaching & Learning, reviewed the new proposed Policy 3411 for Accommodating Students with Seizure Disorders or Epilepsy. The proposed policy will have a second reading at the September Board meeting.
- Superintendent's Report: Tim Merlino, Superintendent, briefed the board on the following:
 - A. SCHOOL DISTRICT LEVY UPDATE
 - B. WAITSBURG SCHOOL DISTRICT: will join the ESA as a provisional member.

- C. <u>DISTRICT 5 VACANCY</u>: Tim shared an update on three possible candidates for the board vacancy.
 - Two members shared that they cannot attend the board meeting scheduled for September 27, 2022. A motion was made to reschedule the meeting.
- D. <u>COVID PROTOCOLS</u>: The Washington State Department of Health has new guidelines for students and schools but there are not any significant changes. ESD 112 will continue to follow existing practices.
- E. <u>LEGISLATIVE UPDATE</u>: Tim shared that a tour will be scheduled for legislators of recent facility updates in the Skamania School District. Thanks to a four-million-dollar investment, building life was extended by 40 years. Legislators will be invited to see the updates and impact of the funding.
- F. <u>CONGRESSIONAL BRIEF</u>: Tim shared a copy of the federal congressional brief.
- G. <u>ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES</u>: At the request of the board chair, steps are being taken to move to an electronic signature process for board materials that require approval.
- H. <u>FROM SEED TO APPLE</u>: "From Seed to Apple" books were provided to each board member by OSPI that share inspirational stories and lessons learned from Washington's Teachers of the Year.
