

Executive or Closed Sessions

Executive Sessions

When necessary to discuss matters the law authorize the Board to discuss in an executive session, the President or a majority of the Board may call an executive session, or the Board may recess from a regular meeting to an executive session. No official action will be taken in executive session, and any conclusions or decisions arrived at shall be in the form of recommendations to be made to the Board when it reconvenes.

Collective Bargaining Sessions

The Open Public Meetings Act does not apply to collective bargaining sessions, professional contract negotiations with employees, grievances or discussions relating to the interpretation or application of a labor agreement. Public notice is not required prior to holding closed session discussions of this nature and will not be provided.
