

Program Participant Health Policy

The Board authorizes ESD 112 program directors to arrange for health services to be provided to all children and youth enrolled in ESD 112 programs. Health services will be provided in compliance with ESD policy, federal and state laws. Where federal or state law is more restrictive or contradicts with ESD policy, programs will be carried out in accordance with federal or state law. Such services will include but not be limited to:

- A. The maintenance of program participant health records;
- B. The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of program participants who become ill during the school day;
- C. Consulting services of a qualified health specialist;
- D. Vision (both distance and near) and hearing screening;
- E. Immunization records and screening; and
- F. Administration of medication.
