Staff Safety

The Board of Directors is committed to providing a safe and healthful environment for all students and employees. In fulfilling that commitment, the Board directs the Superintendent to develop programs and guidelines that provide for:

- 1. a safe and healthy work environment;
- 2. safety information and training;
- 3. accident prevention;
- 4. prevention of transmission of communicable diseases;
- 5. compliance with state and federal safety acts;
- 6. reporting and recording of accidents and potential hazards; and
- 7. emergency preparedness.
