Applicant Qualifications

Retooling applicants to ESD-U currently hold a **Washington state teaching certificate**, are **employed as a teacher in a Washington school district or ESD**, and are **seeking an additional endorsement**.

Priority will be given to those currently employed in districts partnering with the ESD-U program.



Scholarships Available

Retooling candidates can apply for a scholarship through the Washington Student Achievement Council (WASAC). To qualify, you must be seeking an endorsement in a shortage subject area. ESD-U currently offers endorsements in the following areas: Special Education, Elementary Education, English Language Learners, and Reading.
