

ESD 112 Board of Directors Business Meeting February 25, 2025

CALL TO ORDER

The ESD 112 Board of Directors Business meeting was called to order by Heidi Rosenberg, *President*, at 3:00 pm on February 25, 2025, with a quorum of seven members present.

REPORTS AND DISCUSSION

- <u>ESD 112 Regional Teacher of the Year</u>: Effie Triol introduced Rachel Lake, Ocean Beach School District, who is the ESD 112 Regional Reacher of the Year for 2024. Rachel shared her experiences as a music teacher in a small school district and expressed the importance of electives in all schools.
- <u>Program Highlight: Construction Services Group</u>: Dax Logsdon, *Construction Services Group Director*, and Jennifer Halleck, *Associate Director of Constructions Services, Operations & Programs*, shared an update with focus on tsunami and seismic updates for schools.
- <u>Early Head Start & ECEAP Monthly Report:</u> Tina Vessey, *Compliance & Quality Assurance Manager*, shared highlights of January's report and the 2024 Annual Report. Enrollment has increased and meets state requirements. Staffing remains an issue with job openings outnumbering incoming staff. Heidi Rosenberg, *Board Policy Council Liaison*, shared an update on the February Policy Council Meeting.
- <u>First Reading of Revised Policies:</u> Marnie Allen, *Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources, and Insurance Programs*, reviewed proposed changes to policies 3205 and 5011 which reverts the language to 2020 Title IX regulations in compliance with state and federal law.
- Superintendent's Report: Tim Merlino, Superintendent, briefed the board on the following:
 - <u>Levy and Bond Update</u>: Superintendent Merlino shared an update on results for levies and bonds elections in the region on February 11, 2025.
 - Roosevelt School District Update: Tim Merlino and Mike Nerland, Assistant Superintendent of Teaching & Learning, recently attend a Roosevelt School District board meeting. There is interest in continuing superintendent services in the 25-26 school year.
 - <u>State Budget</u>: A state budget shortfall is expected. The amount of the predicted shortfall continues to increase, which may impact some ESD programs. K-12 basic funding has been excluded from requests for proposed budget reductions from the Governor.
 - <u>Special Education ESA</u>: Mabton and Index School Districts have expressed interest in joining the ESA.
 - <u>Federal Update</u>: There have been no reductions to federally funded ESD programs. The board requested a discussion regarding sample WSSDA policy 4300 at the March business meeting.

- <u>March Board Retreat</u>: Superintendent Merlino reviewed the draft schedule for the board retreat scheduled for March 24, 2025.
- ESD 112 Annual Audit: Field work is expected to be completed in the next week.
- <u>Proposed Budget Timeline</u>: The proposed timeline for approval of next year's budget was reviewed.
- <u>Promoting Public Schools</u>: Superintendents have requested help from the ESD to create a communication program to promote public schools.
- <u>Selection of AESD Award of Distinction Artwork</u>: Board members reviewed entries in the Regional High School Art Show and selected a piece which will be presented to this year's AESD Award of Distinction recipient. Board members selected a photograph taken by Leonell Alpyorov, River Homelink.
- <u>Employee Acknowledgements & Recognitions</u>: Monique Dugaw, *Executive Director of Communications & Public Relations*, recognized Jill Driver, *Special Education Teacher*, for engaging students in their own paths to success. Jill serves students in the Methow Valley School District.

PROPOSALS FOR ACTION

- Motion passed: to approve the consent agenda items including minutes from the ESD 112 Board of Directors Business Meeting January 28, 2025; Personnel Activity Report for January 2025; Expenditure Reports for January 2025; and EHS Expenditure Reports for January 2025.
