#### **Anti-bias Film Series**





This training series explores anti-bias education (ABE) with the film, Reflecting on Anti-Bias Education in Action: The Early Years (2021, Lee Keenan, D., & Nimmo, J.) as its foundation. Anti-Bias Education builds on the strengths and knowledge children bring to school, and encourages teachers to observe carefully, think critically, and reflect deeply in their programs. The film is organized around 4 interconnected goals of anti-bias education (Identity, Diversity, Justice, and Action). These goals build on each other and are relevant to all children and adults. The first 4 sessions we will view selected sections of the film; define and discuss ABE goals and reflection questions from the film study guide. The 5th & final session will allow us time to reflect on the film, review the current NAEYC Advancing Equity Position statement, and questions concerning putting this into practice in programs.

#### **Transitions in Preschool & Pre-K Environments**



This training will focus on the multiple aspects involved and occurring in transitions that exist within Preschool environments. This includes information about transitions/changes that take place in a child's life (outside of school environment) including developmental, within family life; changes and transitions that occur on a yearly basis (classroom change, etc.), and within a child's individual day. We will also look at transitions as they apply to both groups of children as well as individual children. Also considered will be how various transitions can affect adults within an early learning environment. Training will offer information around all the previous issues, as well as offer suggestions for making transitions smoother for participants.
