What is something fun you did at REACH recently?

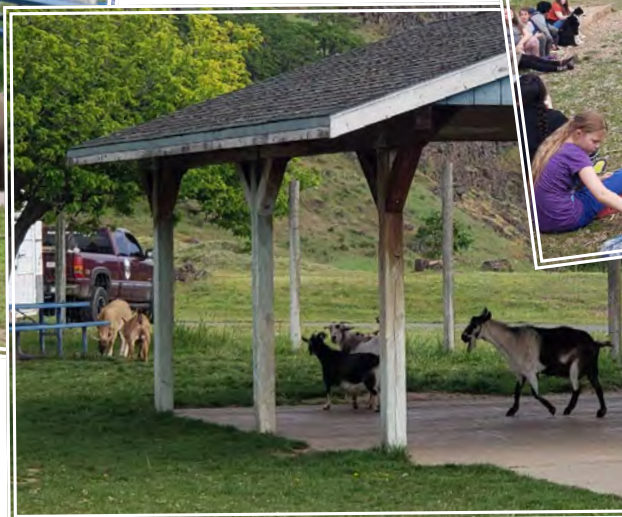
"I love art, so any art activities are fun!"
