Applicant Qualifications

Applicants to ESD-U currently hold a **bachelor's degree** and are **seeking a teaching certificate**. Applicants may need to take prerequisite tests before beginning the program. Priority will be given to those currently employed in districts partnering with the ESD-U program.



Scholarships Available

30 scholarships for up to \$5,000 will be available through the ESD-U program grant awarded by the Professional Educator Standards Board (PESB) and will be awarded to candidates based on district needs.
